

Sport: CURLING

1. Equipment and Facility Requirements

- In accordance with current SHSAA specifications. See SHSAA handbook.
- A minimum of three sheets of ice (preferably artificial) are required.
- All standard curling equipment may be used.

2. Entries

- E5 forms must be forwarded to the SHSAA by early December. E5 forms must be forwarded to the District commissioner no later than 3 weeks prior to District competition.
- District commissioner will set up draws in accordance to schools that have registered teams with the SHSAA.

3. Rules of Play

- District and Regional Competitions will follow rules of play as outlined in SHSAA handbook

4. Officials

- The commissioner is encouraged to arrange for qualified judges to be present for all games.

5. Play-off Structure

- When our districts are held in a 3 or 4 sheet facility we will use a double knock out 8 team draw. Representation will be as follows:
 - 1) P.A. City 2 – Carlton, Valois, Wesmor, and PACI
 - 2) Parkland 2 - Debden, Shellbrook, Canwood, Big River
 - 3) P. A. Catholic 1 – St. Mary and Rivier
 - 4) P.A. Rural 2 - Meath Park, Birch Hills, Kinistino, St. Louis
 - 5) Missinipe 1 – All northern schools
- *In the event that an area is unable to fill their position, the open spot will go to another area determined by the NCDAA executive
- When our districts are held at PAGCC schools will be allowed to enter an unlimited number of teams.

6. Time Guidelines

- The tournament should be held on a Friday starting around noon and all day Saturday.
- At least two hours and fifteen minutes should be allowed for all games.

7. Awards

- District medals are awarded to the individual team winners.
