

Sport: Badminton

1. Equipment and facility requirements
 - a. In accordance with current SHSAA specifications. See SHSAA handbook.
 - b. All players in doubles events must wear protective glasses unless regular prescription glasses are worn.
2. Entries
 - a. E-5 form must be completed by the second week of April and forwarded to the SHSAA office and the district commissioner by required date of SHSAA
 - b. Conference commissioners must submit their entries to the district commissioner by the date set out at the NCDAA meeting.
 - c. Participants may enter only one event. Coaches must enter the names of all eligible players on the entry and forward the entries to the district commissioner.
3. Playoff Structure
 - a. 12 team double knockout – top 2 teams advancing to Regional Playoffs
 - b. Top 4 seeds are based on last year's results
 - c. The commissioner must let the executive report the top 4 finishers in all 5 events so that the following year's draw may be made.

Representation will be as follows:

P.A. City - 2 – Carlton, Ecole Valois, Wesmor, PACI, and Family Church Academy.

Parkland - 3 - Debden, W.P. Sandin, Canwood, Big River, Ahtahkakoop, and Se Se Wa Hum

P. A. Catholic – 2 – St. Mary and Rivier

P.A. Rural - 3 - Meath Park, Birch Hills, Kinistino, St. Louis, Sturgeon Lake, Little Red River Education Center, and Muskoday First Nations.

Missinippe 2 – Senator Myles Venne, Father Paorte Memorial, Kimosom Pwatinahk Collegiate, Father Gamache, Churchill Community High School, Sally Ross, Senator Allan Bird Memorial, Wapawikoscikan, Hector Thiboutot, Reindeer Lake, Rhonda Hardlotte Keethanow, and Father Merget.

If a conference does not fill its representation, the draw will be adjusted accordingly

4. Rules of Play

Current SHSAA guidelines will be followed, including:

- a. Games are played to 21 points. Third game teams switch ends at 11
 - b. Games are capped at 30
 - c. A match winner wins the best of 3 games.
 - d. The Honor System will be used.
 - e. Any disputes or questions should be brought to the attention of the commissioner.
5. Officials
 - a. The district will attempt to have a Badminton official at the host site.
 6. Play-off Structure: Double Knock out 16 team draw
 7. Time Guidelines: Competition will be played on the Saturday before Regional playoffs. If this is not possible because of the Easter break or unforeseeable circumstances the playoffs will be held on a weekday no later than the entry deadline for Regionals.
 8. Awards - District medals are awarded to the individual winners.
